The 2011 MISD Bond proposal for \$97.3 M will fund the design and construction of a high school, an elementary school, and additions to Frank Seale Middle School. Here's why you should **VOTE YES** for this bond.

**Our district is growing! We must be prepared.**

Between 200-275 new students per year moved into the Midlothian ISD over the past 4 years.

**Our high school exceeds "functional capacity"** and by 2012 will exceed "maximum capacity" of 2500 students.

**Portable buildings won't work.** They would only be a **"temporary solution"** that would take away student parking and significantly increase costs to taxpayers.

9th/10th grade centers were considered but four year **high schools cost less over time** and allow students to better integrate into their school community.

An additional high school will **double opportunities** for our high school students, as well as teachers and staff. Frank Seale needs **additional class room space** to accommodate new middle schoolers.

**JR Irvin will exceed capacity in 2012** and our other elementary schools are close behind, which puts **students in many neighborhoods at risk** of being moved to different schools every year.

**We must break ground** on these core educational facilities **by early 2012** to accommodate growth that is coming and to avoid disrupting students with frequent moves and temporary quick-fixes.

**Construction costs are down** due to the economy and by building these schools now we can get far more value for our dollars. **We need to act NOW.**

The bond covers **"development /building costs" only.** Funds for teachers and operating costs are separate and will be covered by the **additional state funds** that our district gets for each additional student.

**Seniors and the disabled are exempt** and will **NOT** have tax increases by this bond. This bond will only cost approximately **\$10/month for a \$200K home.**

Our schools are **the foundation of our community** and **the backbone of our property values.** Invest in your children, through our schools, for our community.

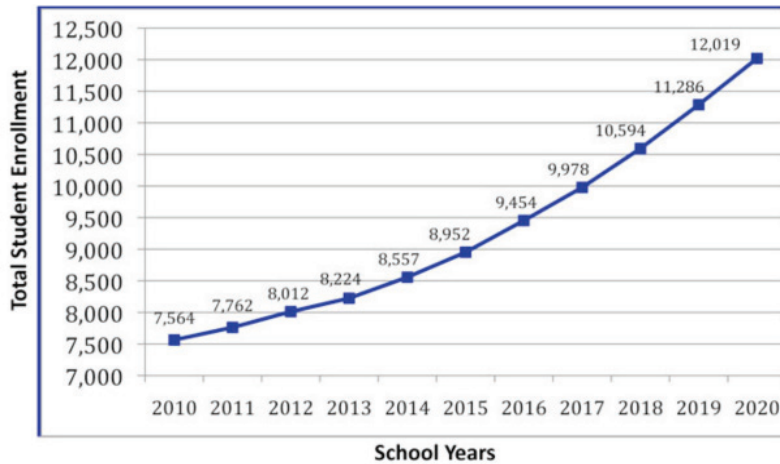
